## Heart to Heart with Rev. Kenneth Hagin Jr.

I also love to proclaim my freedom in Christ. Because Jesus went to a place called Golgotha and laid down His life, His blood was shed so all mankind might be spiritually free. We've been redeemed from sickness, sin, and poverty!

This redemption is one of righteousness. Second Corinthians 5:21 says, "For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

Many people have their thinking mixed up when it comes to righteousness. They think that righteousness is some spiritual status they must attain. But that's not true. *Righteousness* is "right-standing with God." Anyone who has been born again through the blood of Christ is righteous. They are not going to get any more righteous than they are right now.

Growing in God and gaining more knowledge of "who God is" has nothing to do with righteousness. You see, someone who is newly saved is just as righteous as the person who's been saved for 35 years.

Although righteousness has nothing to do with spiritual growth, it's imperative that we grow spiritually. In fact, the Apostle Paul talks to us about the fact that we need to be weaned of the "milk" of the Word and begin eating "meat" (Heb. 5:12).

Naturally speaking, there comes a point in every child's life when a parent will say, "You're old enough to pick up your toys." Or, "You're old enough to get the milk from the refrigerator and the cereal from the cupboard."

Like young children, Christians must also grow up. We must learn who we are in Christ and begin operating in the authority we have in Jesus. You see, Jesus did everything He is going to do. 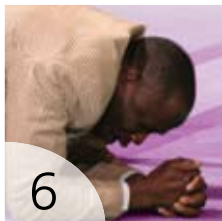

# Jesus Christ CURES X YOU!

*And it came to pass, as Peter passed throughout all quarters, he came down also to the saints which dwelt at Lydda.*

*And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy.*

*And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately.*

*And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.*

—Acts 9:32–35



**T**his portion of Scripture tells the story of a helpless paralytic named Aeneas, who was healed when Peter told him, “. . . Aeneas, Jesus Christ cures you . . .” (Acts 9:34 *Weymouth*).

As the story opens, we see a man named Peter who has been scurrying from town to town, village to village, synagogue to synagogue, and anywhere else he could preach.

Peter is telling the people about Jesus Christ, the Man with Whom he walked; the Man Whom he saw die on the cross; the Man Whom he saw ascend from the Mount of Olives on a cloud of glory after telling His disciples, “. . . tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high” (Luke 24:49).

And now Peter has come to Lydda. Can't you see him as he finishes his first service and one of the brethren runs up to him and says, “Oh, Peter, we've got a sad case here—a man by the name of

Aeneas. He has been paralyzed for eight years. Will you go see him? He can't make it out to the services.”

In my mind's eye, I go down to Aeneas' house with Peter. I see Peter approach Aeneas' sickbed, and I see Aeneas look up sadly.

He asks Peter, “What are you doing here? I've tried all the doctors. I've done everything I know to do, and I'm still not any better. They say it's incurable. What kind of a new idea do *you* have?”

I see a smile break across Peter's face. I know immediately that his mind is racing back to a certain day just after the Holy Spirit had been poured out—a day recounted in the third chapter of Acts.

In his mind, Peter walks up once again to the Gate called Beautiful. A wretched beggar sits beside the gate. He stinks with the stench of all the animals and people who have been walking by, kicking dust and dirt on him.

There the beggar sits, shaking that little tin cup, rattling those coins in the bottom of it as if to say, “Give me some money!”

I see Peter as he walks up to the man and says, “I don't have any silver, and I don't have any gold. But such as I have, give I you” (Acts 3:1–8).

Peter saw that beggar leap and walk that day, healed by the power of God. And as he looks down at Aeneas, he says, “Aeneas, I can help you!”

Everything has been purchased for you. It is now time for you to arise and receive.

I am sure Peter also told Aeneas, “Now, Aeneas, Jesus Christ is the Son of the Living God. And not only is He the Son of the Living God, but He commissioned me to preach the Gospel, and I was there . . . I saw this Jesus set free the demoniac of the Gadarenes (Mark 5:1–19). I was walking down the road with Him when the 10 lepers came—and they were healed as they went (Luke 17:12–19).

“Aeneas, I was there with Jesus when the ruler Jairus came requesting prayer for his daughter. We were on the way to Jairus’ house when the messengers came and told him, ‘Don’t bother the Master any longer; your daughter is dead.’ I was there, and I saw it. Jesus turned to Jairus and said, ‘Only believe.’

“And, oh, Aeneas, I was there that day in Jairus’ house when Jesus took the

damsel by the hand and raised her from the dead (Mark 5:35–43)!

“Aeneas, let me tell you something else about Jesus. We were walking down the road one day and saw a funeral procession in Nain. And Jesus went over and raised the young man from the dead (Luke 7:11–15).

“And, Aeneas, let me tell you something else: *Jesus Christ now cures you! Arise and walk!*”

Aeneas’ faith was so high that he leaped out of that bed. Jesus Christ, the Man Aeneas believed in, had healed him too! And the Word of God says that all of Lydda and Saron saw his healing and turned to the Lord.

Notice that the miracle of his healing occurred *after* the Day of Pentecost. That puts it within this present dispensation of the Holy Spirit, for we are living in the same dispensation as the Early Church. If

I have studied the Word correctly, then it is true that as long as we are living in the same dispensation, all of the spiritual and scriptural laws pertaining to that dispensation are still in effect. Therefore, healing is still in effect for us today.

The difference between Old and New Testament dispensations is that in the Old Testament, the only ones anointed by the Spirit of God were prophets, priests, and kings.

Today, it is not necessary for a prophet to hear from God on our behalf; we can hear the voice of God ourselves. We have the anointing, or power, of God available to us. We can take what God says in His Word, believe it, act on it, and receive it for ourselves.

That is why it is now up to you to receive whatever you want from God. Everything has been purchased for you. It is now time for you to arise and receive.

Peter said, “Aeneas, Jesus Christ cures you. Arise!”

That same Jesus is still walking up and down the earth by His Holy Spirit—and that same Jesus will cure you!

You can take that verse of Scripture and put your name in it: “John, Jesus Christ cures you.” “Barbara, Jesus Christ cures you.” “Ruth, Jesus Christ cures you.”

I say to you, “*Jesus Christ cures you! Arise and receive your healing—right now!*” ♥

## Highlights From Winter Bible Seminar 2007

With these words, Rev. Kenneth Hagin Jr. boldly challenged each person attending *Winter Bible Seminar 2007* to be fully committed to the purpose God has for their lives. Each year, *Winter Bible Seminar* is a time for ministers and lay people to gather together and worship the Lord. It is a time to be refreshed in His presence and to receive His divine direction. This year, people came ready to receive from the Lord and to rise up in

the purposes He has for them. And *Winter Bible Seminar* delivered!

Rev. Hagin spoke passionately about the need for Christians everywhere—people of like mind and purpose—to come together and minister to each other and the Lord. The speakers at this year’s *Winter Bible Seminar* did exactly that by encouraging attendees to remember the importance of worship, consecration, prayer, commitment, and faith to fulfilling God’s plan for their lives.

*Winter Bible Seminar’s* attendees enjoyed wonderful times of praise and worship. They soaked in thought-provoking teachings. They prayed. And they acted in faith to receive God’s promises.

Revs. Ken and Lynette Hagin ministered healing to many people, several of whom testified to seeing instant results.

Many people who had been suffering from back pain received immediate relief after hands were laid on them, including one man with a ruptured disk and another who had experienced chronic pain for seven years. A man with voice box problems left a service able to speak again. And a number of people had growths and lumps disappear from their bodies as a result of receiving prayer.

As always, Rev. Hagin reminded his hearers that the ultimate purpose for God’s promises is to enable His people to be vessels He can work through to reach those in need of His grace. *Winter Bible Seminar* culminated with a powerful message delivered during the Thursday evening service. Speaking passionately about the role of Kenneth Hagin Ministries and RHEMA Bible Training





Center in these last days, Rev. Hagin exhorted the crowd to focus on the divine purpose for their lives and take action *now* to see that purpose accomplished. He explained that the way we see this happen is through our faith.

*The following is adapted from Rev. Hagin's Thursday night message.*

The life of faith requires us to know the principles of faith, but it also requires us to have a spirit of faith.

People with a spirit of faith always go beyond their present boundaries. They're not afraid to face the unknown. They look out and see something beyond the place where they are. They see God as the supplier of all their needs.

People with a spirit of faith believe God to help them do exploits. They're builders. They cultivate the dry land. They turn deserts into oases. They create something out of nothing. They call things that be not as though they are. Don't be afraid to

step out and take the spirit of faith where no one else has gone.

Many of you are connected with Kenneth Hagin Ministries because this is where you learned about faith and the authority of the believer. My dad, Kenneth E. Hagin, did what he could to make sure our generation knew about the spirit of faith. Now it's up to us to train the next generation to have that same spirit of faith.

We must invest in the future now.

**“When you consecrate yourself to fulfill the call of God, you will become the place where Heaven's blessing meets Earth's greatest need. You'll become a vessel of power, walking forth to do the will of God.”**

When people get a glimpse of the future, they will make sacrifices today to reap the results later on. The next generation is depending on us to fight battles

today so they can have a future with God tomorrow.

We must realize that the future belongs to those who are willing to rise up in the spirit of faith and take steps to possess what God says belongs to us. As we look to the future, we can see a world of opportunities for those who will totally commit themselves to Christ. There is a world of opportunities to preach the Gospel.

If we're going to take the Gospel to our world and fulfill our God-given purpose, we must realize that the future belongs to those who are willing to invest in it. We can't afford to sit down, be satisfied and complacent, and enjoy ourselves while others are perishing without God.

We must not be complacent or satisfied with where we are. Don't think you've seen everything yet. It's time to look with the eyes of faith to the harvest fields of this world. It is time to rise up. Get ready to move with God! ♠

During the daily sessions of prayer and teaching, attendees spent time ministering to the Lord, an

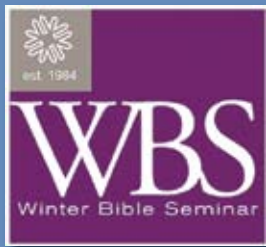

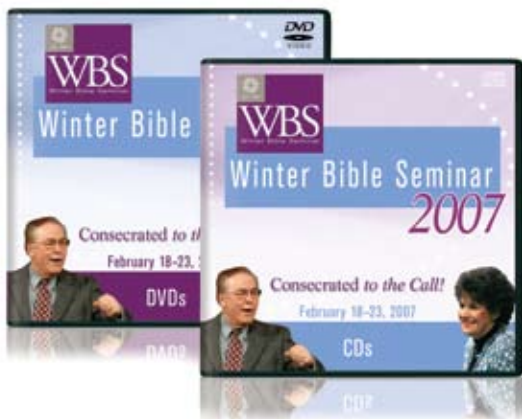

another student. “God used the school to further equip me and strengthen me as His servant. I can say that I have become more fruitful in my ministry now.”

RHEMA Indonesia is enjoying divine favor. With God’s help, it has become registered as a “religious training center” fully recognized by the government’s Ministry of Education and Religion. RHEMA’s legal advisers say such a high caliber of recognition is a miracle. Most Bible schools are registered under local churches.

Personally, the Tanokos are undergirded by the biblical truths deposited into their lives through instructors at RHEMA Bible Training Center USA. Those truths are now producing fruit in Indonesian believers halfway around the world. That fruit is evident in the students’ testimonies. As one student said, “I have learned who I am in Christ and no longer worry about the future. Through the school, I understand my calling and the steps to take to fulfill it for God’s glory.”

*At Kenneth Hagin Ministries, it is our heart’s desire that our partners and friends feel connected to what we’re doing around the world. Because many people seeking to fulfill God’s call are unable to travel to the United States for training, we have planted RHEMA Bible Training Centers around the globe. This month, we are featuring RHEMA Bible Training Center Indonesia.*

**H**ow do you preach the Gospel in a land where nine out of 10 citizens embrace a religion that is openly hostile to the Word of God?

You do more than *talk* about truth—you *demonstrate* it with signs, wonders, and miracles. That’s what the directors and students of RHEMA Bible Training Center Indonesia have been doing since the school was founded in September 2004.

Roughly 215 million Indonesians claim Islam as their religion. The Southeast Asian archipelago—a collection of more than 17,000 islands (6,000 inhabited) between the Indian and Pacific oceans—has the largest Muslim population of any nation on earth. Still, RHEMA is undaunted in its mission of teaching faith in the living God. And He is faithfully and powerfully demonstrating the truth of His Word and granting extraordinary favor.

“We show the Gospel through our changed lives and the miracle-working power of God,” explained Rev. Andrew Tanoko, who serves as director of RHEMA Indonesia with his wife, Rachel. “Muslims’ ears are shut to the Bible. But their eyes can see the difference the Gospel makes in Christians’ lives and the miracles that confirm the Word being preached.” Confronted with the reality of the power in God’s Word and the love Christians show, Muslims become willing to listen.

To reach more people, RHEMA is building trust among churches. The school’s presence is attracting students from different denominations who want to train for the ministry. RBTC Indonesia recently graduated 27 students from 18 different churches representing congregations from eight denominations in eight provinces. Training pastors and leaders is the key to bringing the light of the Gospel to the nation’s 245 million citizens. A wave of miracles and healing is sweeping through existing churches.

“Through RHEMA, I have learned truths about healing—God wants to heal us, and we should expect healings even right now,” said one RHEMA student. “We have opened a healing school in our church. Miracles are already happening to the glory of God.”

Most churches are embracing the move of God, but many more churches are needed to help reach the millions who have not yet heard the Gospel. Fortunately, Indonesian Christians have a passion for planting new fellowships—and RHEMA shares that passion. RHEMA is committed to fully equipping students whose ministries will produce more fruit in existing churches and fuel efforts to pioneer new ones. RBTC Indonesia is already seeing results from this effort.

“I have been serving in the children’s church, youth church, and prayer ministry since before I came to RHEMA,” said

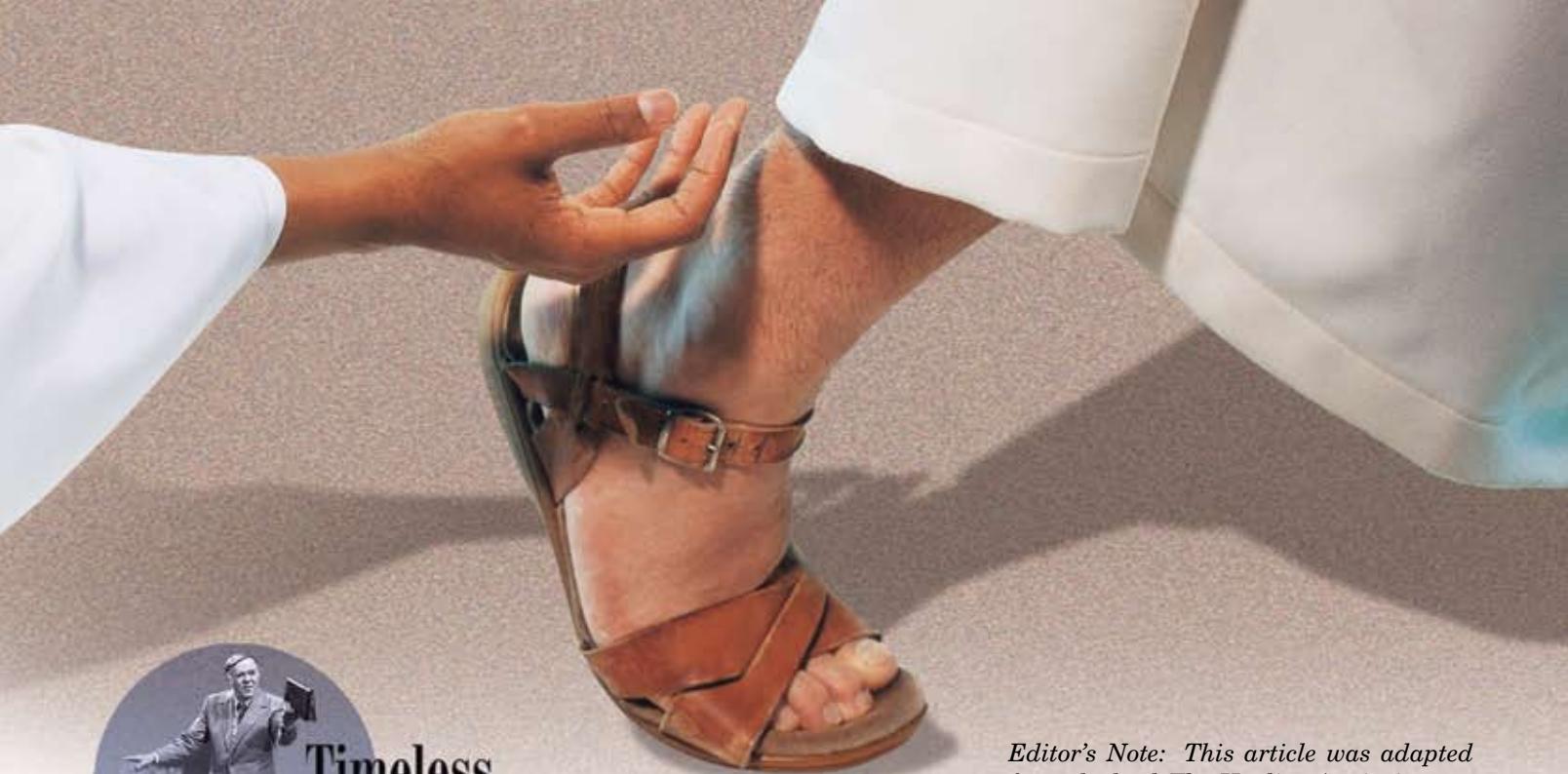

# How You Can Receive Divine Healing

... and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

—Isaiah 10:27

**O**ur text says, "... the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing." We sometimes say it like this: "It's the anointing that destroys the yoke," or "It's the anointing that *breaks* the yoke." Well, if the anointing *destroys* the yoke, it *breaks* it!

In this article, I've applied Isaiah 10:27 to healing because I'm talking primarily about the healing anointing. Therefore, we could say that it is the anointing that destroys or breaks the yoke of *sickness*. Thank God for the anointing!

When we use the term "anointing," we are talking about the power of God. I will use these words—*anointing* and *power*—interchangeably throughout this teaching.

I also want to talk about the *results* of the mighty healing power of God, or the healing anointing. But we can't do a thorough study of the healing anointing without discussing how to *obtain* the results—how to get the anointing working in your own life to produce results.

We know that in order to get the anointing to work, we've got to understand something about the operation of the anointing. For example, we know that the anointing is *transmittable* and

that it can be transmitted or transferred through certain substances, such as cloth. We also know that the anointing is *measurable*, as in the case of Elijah and Elisha. Elisha received a double portion or twice as much of the anointing with which Elijah was anointed.

Furthermore, the anointing is *tangible*, as illustrated in the case of the woman with the issue of blood. Jesus was aware of the *outflow* of power. He said, "Who touched My clothes?" And the woman was aware of the *inflow* of power: "... she **FELT** in her body that she was healed of that plague" (Mark 5:29).

Well, if you can feel something, then it is tangible. *Tangible* means "capable of being touched or perceptible to the touch."

We understand more now about the power of God, or the anointing. The power is *transmittable*, *measurable*, and *tangible*. But to get the anointing (or power) to work effectually, we also have to understand mixing faith *with* the power so we can realize the blessings and benefits of the anointing.

Many people have missed it because they imagined that if the tangible healing

anointing is present, it will just manifest itself and do the job. But that's not necessarily true.

We need to see what the *Bible* says about the healing anointing. And, of course, when we look at what the Bible says, we can't overlook the ministry of Jesus, because Jesus ministered with that anointing during His earth walk.

In this article, we're studying the healing anointing as a means to obtain healing, but Jesus ministered healing to people in various ways—the healing anointing was only one way whereby Jesus ministered healing during His earthly ministry. There was not always a transfer of healing power (or anointing) from Jesus to another person. *Sometimes* there was a transfer of power, but at other times there wasn't.

For example, Jesus ministered to the 10 lepers without ever touching them. No power flowed out of Jesus to the lepers. Jesus just said to them, "... Go shew yourselves unto the priests . . ." (Luke 17:14). And it says that as they went, they were cleansed.



## FAITH IN ACTION

### Faith to Be Healed

There is no set way to receive healing. There are a number of methods in God's Word for receiving healing. Thank God, all of them work! Although the healing anointing was emphasized in *Timeless Teachings*, you can receive divine healing through any of the ways listed below:

1. Use your faith in the Word of God. (Proverbs 4:20-23; John 16:23; Mark 11:23-24)
2. Call for the elders of the church to pray for you. (James 5:14)
3. Pray the prayer of agreement with another believer. (Matthew 18:18-20)
4. Have hands laid on you in prayer. (Mark 16:15-20; Hebrews 6:1-2)
5. Partake of the Lord's Supper. (1 Corinthians 11:23-30)
6. Exercise your faith in the Name of Jesus. (John 14:12-14; Acts 3:6, 16)

When you refuse to be moved by what you see or feel in your body and never move off God's Word, you will receive healing in your body.

We can also read in Matthew 8:5-6 about the centurion who came to Jesus on behalf of his servant who was very sick.

#### MATTHEW 8:5-6

**5** And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

**6** And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

Notice how Jesus responded.

#### MATTHEW 8:7-10

**7** And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.

**8** The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

**9** For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.

**10** When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

Then verse 13 says, ". . . Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as

*thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the self-same hour.*"

There wasn't any anointing that flowed from Jesus into that servant; the servant was some distance away. No, the centurion *just acted on the Word of Jesus*: "Go your way. And as you have believed, so be it done unto you!"

You see, faith in God's Word works whether or not there's any tangible anointing, because the Word of God is already anointed! Jesus said, ". . . the words that I speak unto you, they are SPIRIT, and they are life" (John 6:63).

The Bible also says about the Word, ". . . holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost" (2 Peter 1:21). Holy men of old wrote *as they were moved by the Holy Ghost!* This is the *anointed Word of God!*

In conclusion, the healing anointing is a tangible substance. And the Word of God reveals to us the rules and laws that govern its operation.

The Lord Jesus Christ revealed and applied the laws of the Spirit, which demonstrated the fact that the healing power of God is a tangible substance, a heavenly materiality.

You'll not receive any of this power from Heaven if you don't believe there's any there. If you don't believe it exists, you'll never apply it to your circumstances. Therefore, this power will not benefit you until you believe in it, lay hold of it intelligently by faith, and simply receive it.

Through your faith in the holy written Word and in the mighty power of God, you can receive divine healing! By believing what God's Word says about the healing anointing, you can enjoy all the blessings and benefits that are available to us today through this power from Heaven. ♠



# Focus on Healing

*Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.*

—3 John 2 (NKJV)

## The Power of Prayer

“There is nothing we can do. Her brain will swell until she dies . . . and she will probably be dead by morning.” When the doctor spoke these words, Paula Hackworth’s situation appeared hopeless. But things aren’t always what they appear to be.

While Paula had been taking care of her ailing father the year before, she became very sick. She constantly had a high fever and was weak, so she scheduled an appointment with a physician. The doctor thought Paula was having flu complications, and he told her she would get better with time.

Paula was still suffering a few months later and was admitted into the hospital after waking up one morning partially paralyzed. “I thought I had a massive stroke,” Paula recalls. “I could only move my right arm.” A few days later she was released from the hospital—still without answers.

Paula’s symptoms continued to worsen, to the point where her husband was forced to take her to the emergency room. That’s when they received the grim news. The doctor in the emergency room said, “She has a virus that causes chronic fatigue syndrome and viral meningitis, and it is in the very last stages. There is nothing we can do. Her brain will swell until she dies. She will probably be dead by

morning. There’s no use putting her in the intensive care unit.” So the hospital staff put Paula in a spare room, attached her to a heart monitor, and waited for her to die.

Instead of going home to wait for his wife to die, Paula’s husband went home and called RHEMA. It was on a Sunday, so during the Sunday evening service at RHEMA Bible Church, the congregation joined their faith together to pray for Paula’s healing.

That evening, Paula’s hearing began to fade, and she had the sensation that she was dying. “I knew I was dying, so I called on the Name of the Lord,” Paula remembers. “And when I did,

God supernaturally spoke to me from John 11:25–26: *‘I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die.’*”

“Up to that point I had been paralyzed,” Paula explains. “The next morning when I woke up, I walked to the bathroom. The nurse rushed into my room because my heart monitor had flatlined. She thought I was dead, but I was in the bathroom! I even asked the nurse for something to eat because I hadn’t been able to eat much the previous three days.”

God miraculously healed Paula. The doctors ran some tests but let her go home a few days later. According to the doctors, Paula should have died the night of March 10, 1985. Now, 22 years later, Paula is still alive and well, working in the helps ministry at her church and teaching others the life-changing truths that raised her off her deathbed.

According to Paula, “The night the church prayed saved my life, because the Lord intervened. I credit my healing to the prayers that night and the teaching I received from RHEMA. I don’t think I’d be alive today if it weren’t for RHEMA.”

### God’s Will Is Healing!

*For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.*

—John 6:38

Healing the sick is God’s will.

Yet Christians who need healing have said to me, “Maybe God put this sickness on me for some purpose.”

Did Jesus ever put sickness on anyone? When people came to Jesus for healing, did He ever turn even one away, saying, “No, it’s not My will. Just suffer a little longer?”

No! Not once!

We can pray for healing with great confidence—knowing it is the will of God!

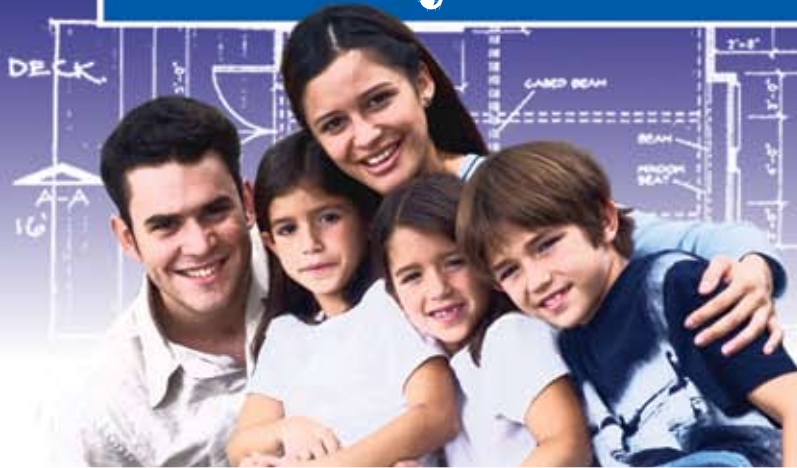
### CONFESSION:

### THIS MONTH'S TOPIC: Healing for the Whole Family

Healing is for the whole family. It is a scriptural fact that Jesus has already done all He is ever going to do about our healing.

The Bible says that Jesus bore "... our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye WERE healed" (1 Peter 2:24). Jesus bore our diseases, our pains, and our sicknesses on the Cross when He died for us (Isaiah 53:4). These scriptures indicate that God has already provided for our healing through Jesus Christ.

### Family Builders for Spouses

#### Faith Steps—For Your Spouse and Family

There are four simple steps that you, your spouse, and your family can put into practice to receive the healing God has provided through Jesus.

1. **Say it.** You must confess healing with your mouth before you ever see results in your body. It is important to speak the truth of the Word no matter what your situation looks like. Say, "Jesus bore my sickness and disease in His own body. Lord, I thank you for my healing! I am healed!"

2. **Do it.** You must take action in your situation. The woman with the issue of blood in the Book of Mark first *said* what she believed and then she *acted* on what she believed by pressing through the crowd to touch Jesus' garment (Mark 5:27-28). We must elbow through the crowd of obstacles that have been standing between us and healing!

3. **Receive it.** The *feeling* and the *healing* follow the *saying* and the *doing*. The power of God to heal is in every place and at every time. We just have to receive it. Rev. Kenneth E. Hagin said of the day he received his healing from an incurable blood disease and heart condition, "Do you think God sent that healing power from Heaven just that day? No! The power was in that room every day of those 16 months I was bedfast. Why didn't it do something? Because I hadn't turned the switch of faith on."

4. **Tell it.** We need to share our victory and what God has done in our lives with others so they, too, can receive healing.

### Family Builders for Children

#### Healing for Your Children

As Jesus explained in the parable of the sower, when the seeds of the Word of God are planted into good ground they will produce a harvest (Matt. 13:23). Children are good ground! They gladly receive the Word of God and mix it with faith."

Parents: consider three things when helping a child receive healing.

1. A parent can believe God on behalf of a young child. A parent has God-given authority over their children that can be exercised for healing.

2. A parent can explain the principles of healing to a child in clear and simple terms. (The four steps to receiving healing outlined previously will work well.)

3. A parent can encourage a child to believe God for himself or herself.



### Family Builders for Teenagers

#### Healing for Your Teen

When a teen needs to receive healing, the most common question they ask is "Will God heal me?"

Here are five things to consider when ministering healing to your teens:

1. It is God's will to heal everyone. God does not pick and choose who He heals.

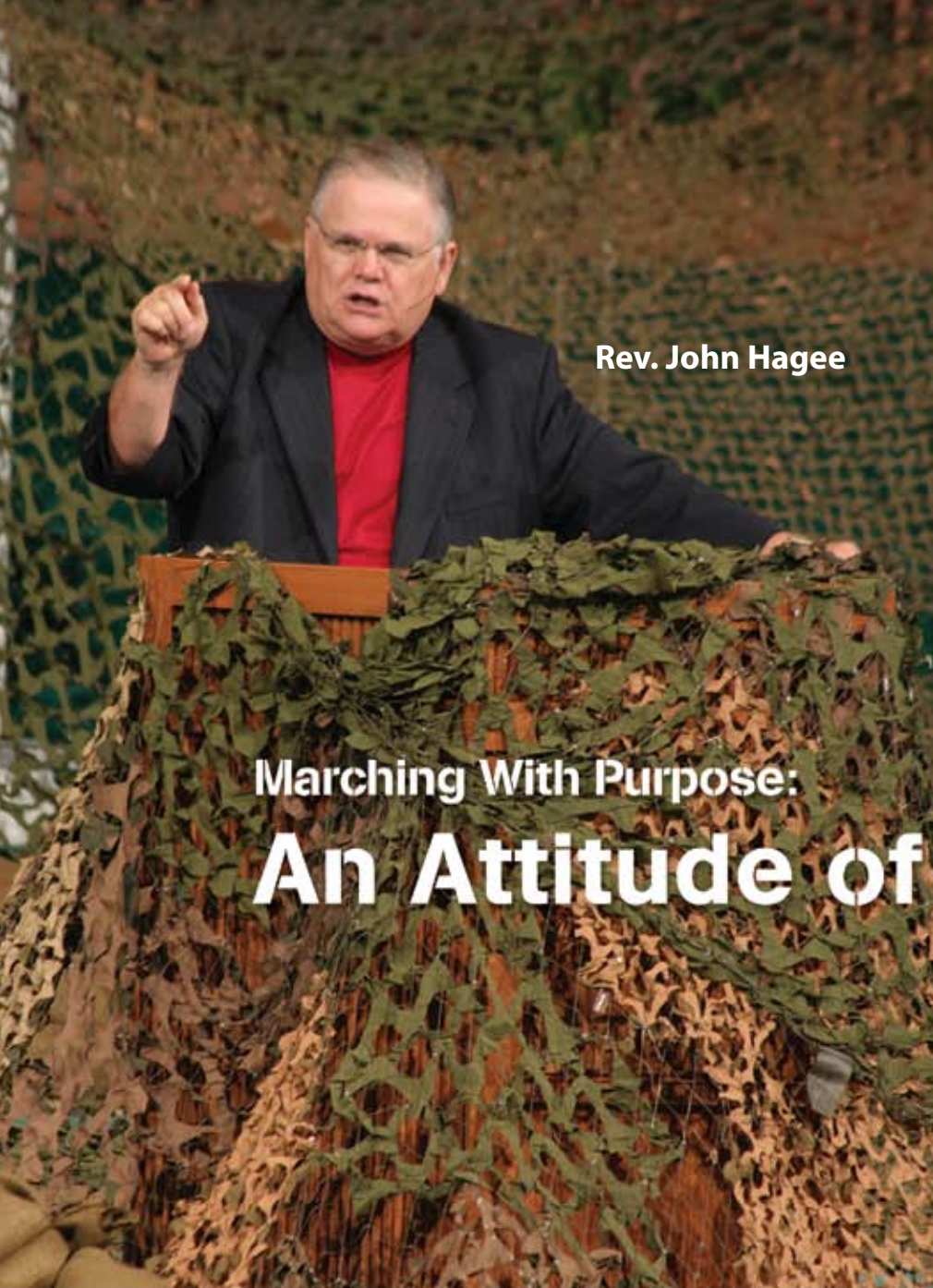
2. God is not trying to teach people anything through sickness.

3. Healing is as much a finished product in the plan of redemption as salvation is.

4. Talk to your teens about healing *before* they get sick so they have faith for healing prior to a need.

5. Teach your teen how to believe they receive *when* they pray, not when they see results (Mark 11:24). Sometimes receiving healing is like taking a Polaroid picture. It takes a little while before the picture develops. Let your teens know that sometimes healing is a process so they are not discouraged if they do not see immediate results. 🕊

## A Message From Kenneth Hagin Jr.'s *A Call to Arms Men's Conference*

*(Editor's Note: In November 2006, more than 1,000 men gathered on the RHEMA USA campus in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, for the fifth annual A Call to Arms Men's Conference. The following article is adapted from John Hagee's Friday evening message.)*

**T**he people who succeed in life are not necessarily the ones with the most talent, highest education, or best job. The people who succeed in life are those who learn to control their thoughts and emotions and harness them under the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

Proverbs 23:7 says that as a man thinks in his heart, that's what he is.

Romans 12:2 says, "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind . . . ."

The fact is that many in the army of God suffer from what I call *stinking thinking*. Their minds are like concrete—thoroughly mixed up and firmly set. Negative, whiny, pity-party attitudes will poison your marriage,

family, church, business, and your soul! Your attitude is contagious. Let the attitude of doubt and fear begin to multiply in what you say, and before you know it, the possibility of the miraculous happening in your life becomes consumed by an atmosphere of total defeat.

The roots of your attitude are hidden, but the fruit is visible. Our attitude draws people to us or repels them. It determines your success or failure in everything you do.

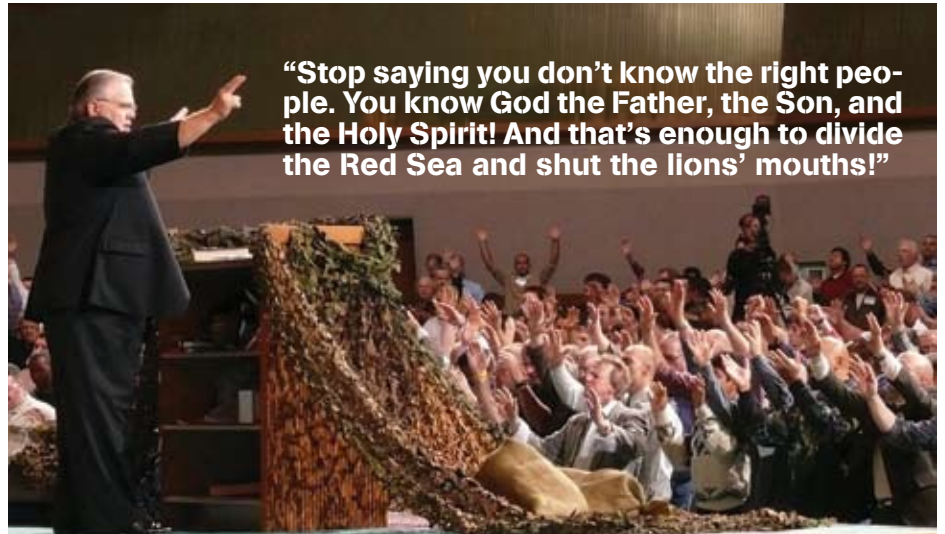
Your attitude determines your attainments. Consider the Apostle Paul,



who was beaten, stoned and left for dead, shipwrecked, bitten by a deadly viper, and thrown into a prison in chains. He wrote in Second Corinthians 4:17 that “our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all” (NIV). Light troubles! But Paul saw them that way because he knew he had victory in Christ.

# Seed Thoughts

“The Lord will guide you always: he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail.” — Isaiah 58:11 (NIV)

This month we set aside a day to honor mothers. I entered the world on Mother’s Day. I occasionally remind my mother, in jest of course, that no present could ever surpass the Mother’s Day gift she received that year. I believe the most beautiful words a mother can hear are recorded in Proverbs 31:28: *“Her children arise up, and call her blessed . . . .”*

Someone once asked a child, “Where is your home?” The little boy replied, “Where mother is.” There is a special place in each child’s heart for their mother. She has the most powerful influence in a child’s life. This gives those of us who are mothers an awesome responsibility to prepare our children for success in life. I would like to give you a few guidelines to help you as you do that.

First and foremost, acquaint your children with the Heavenly Father. The scripture that my parents instilled in me—*“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you”* (Matt. 6:33)—has been the guiding force of my life. I am so thankful that they emphasized that principle to me over and over again. The repetition reminded me constantly that God must have first place.

Many Christians have become so wrapped up in their own work and life that they have neglected their highest calling—the spiritual development of their children. It is very important that you begin training your children at birth. Much of the foundation of a child’s spiritual and character development is laid during infancy. Fifty percent of a child’s character and personality is formed by age three, and 75 percent by age five. Those startling facts remind us that we must begin early to guide our children in their spiritual and character development.

Take time for family devotions. We gathered as a family for devotions every morning before school and read the *Faith Food* devotional that our ministry publishes. It contains daily confessions, and after making those confessions, we asked our children, “What is something that you desire to come to pass in your life?” We encouraged them to make their own personal confessions. Craig was involved in sports, and he would confess, “I can run fast.” Denise had various projects that she desired to come to

pass. It was exciting to see those confessions become realities in their lives.

Show your children love. Child specialists agree that the need for love is present in every human being, and meeting that need is basic to proper development. A parent’s love is more important to a child than wealth, education, or any kind of material possession. Your love as a parent is most important to your child when he is the least lovable. You should not condition your love upon your child’s good behavior. (Have you ever heard someone say, “Mother won’t love you if you are not good”?) A child’s willingness to please should not determine parental love.

The God-kind of love is unconditional. The most important thing is to love your child because they are yours—not because they play the trumpet well or are in the accelerated program at school.

Don’t demand perfection from your child. That is unreasonable. Children lose confidence in themselves and in life when they consistently fail to meet their parents’ expectations. Don’t try to live your unfulfilled dreams through your children by demanding that they excel in an area in which you regret not applying yourself. Do not compare children with their siblings. A child who grows up in the shadow of a brilliant sibling may have a hard time with their self-image.

Lastly, prepare your children for their roles as adults. The only course on marriage most children take is the one taught in their own home. Children learn by imitation. Make sure you are giving them the right things to imitate. Teach your children how to make good decisions, and train them in financial affairs. Believe in your children. Speak positive words into their lives. Remind them that with God they can succeed in life. When a crisis comes involving your children, look to the Lord for direction. Trust Him to give you the right words to say and the right actions to take to turn that situation into a victory in your home.

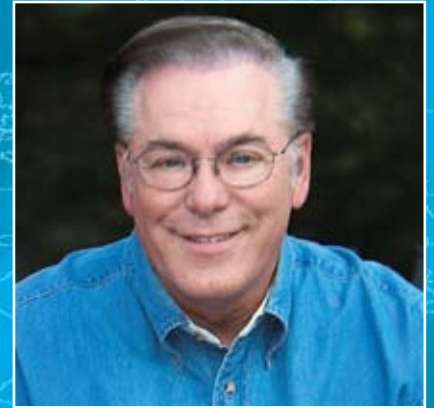
